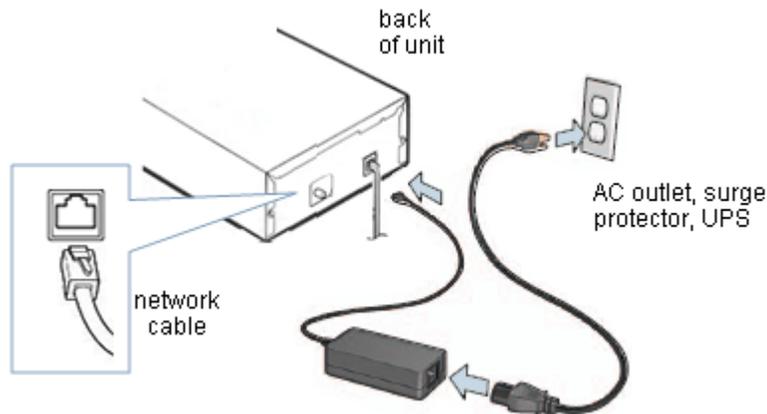


## 1 Install the AudaStation

- 1 Remove all tape and cardboard packing material.
- 2 Connect LAN terminal on the AudaStation to your network using supplied network cable.

**Note** To ensure optimum security, Audatex requires that your AudaStation be installed behind your router's firewall. Consult your router's installation documentation and/or network provider for setup information.

- 3 Connect power cord to the AudaStation.
- 4 Plug in power supply to an AC outlet, surge protector, or uninterruptible power supply (UPS).



- 5 Press and hold down the green checkmark button (  ) to turn the AudaStation on.

## 2 Set up DHCP

- 1 From the Home screen, scroll right to 1. Update Audatex Estimating.
- 2 Scroll down to 3. Setup.
- 3 Scroll right to 3a. Change IP Settings.
- 4 Press .
- 5 Select DHCP.

## Set up Static IP

- 1 From the Home screen, scroll right to 1. Update Audatex Estimating.
- 2 Scroll down to 3. Setup.
- 3 Scroll right to 3a. Change IP Settings.
- 4 Press .
- 5 Scroll right to select Static-IP and press .
- 6 Follow onscreen prompts. Use up/down and left/right arrow buttons to specify static IP settings.

## 3 Update Audatex Application and Data

- 1 Insert the DVD into the DVD-ROM drive of the AudaStation.
- 2 From the Home screen, press right arrow button to scroll right to 1. Update Audatex Estimating. Then press right arrow button again.  
If the latest data is already present in the AudaStation, the following message appears:  
No Upgradable Products on Disk

if an updatable disk is detected, the following message appears:

Logout All Users  
and Upgrade? ✓=OK

- 3 Press  to start upgrade.  
When complete, the following message is displayed:  
Upgrade Complete  
Success!
- 4 Press  to exit from message.

## 4 Back up Data

- 1 Follow instructions in Section 3 "Update Audatex Application and Data."
- 2 Backup occurs during the update process. The following message is displayed:  
Updating Software:  
Backing Up...
- 3 User data is backed up to the \backup folder.
